

Brief report summarizing the activities from the Shinto Muso-ryu Jodo seminar in Iași, Romania

On May 2–3, 2026, a seminar led by Patrik Orth and Renata Vacatová was organized in Iași ([Iași - Wikipedia](#)), Romania, by Adrian Bele (a new student of Patrik Orth Sensei)

Iași is one of the oldest and most culturally significant cities in Romania. It served as a historical capital of the Moldavia region and remains a major academic center, home to the prestigious Alexandru Ioan Cuza University. The city features remarkable architecture, including the iconic Palace of Culture, and today blends its rich history with a vibrant student and cultural life.



During the seminar, Kihon Tandoku (Uchikomi) was studied in depth, approximately half of Kihon Sotai was covered emphasizing precision, timing, and correct distancing in partner work. The sessions supported refinement of core skills and deeper understanding of traditional principles, and an introduction to the Omote Kata was provided.
