Sixth edition of the seminar that proposes the practice of various Japanese martial arts ($Bud\bar{o}$) and Japanese calligraphy ($Shod\bar{o}$), conceived as an opportunity for very intense practice, a true full-immersion

DISCIPLINES

The proposal, following a tradition inaugurated in 1980 with the series of the "Stage des Iles" in France, consists of the practice of:

- Aikidō
- Musō Shinden-ryū laidō
- Shintō Musō-ryū Jōdō
- Shodō

according to a daily work program that begins in the morning before breakfast and ends after dinner, for over 20 hours of total practice

- ▶ Aikido is the discipline founded by Ueshiba Morihei in the 20th century, as a synthesis of barehanded (jujutsu) and armed martial arts. The proposal includes sword (Aikiken) and stick (Aikijo) work.
- ► laidō is the specialty of fencing in which you draw and cut with the sabre in a single blow. The Musō Shinden-ryū (MSR) school is one of the most renowned.
- ► Jodō is a method of stick fencing against a sabre-wielding opponent. The Shintō Musō-ryū (SMR) school, founded in 1605, gave rise to Jodō..
- ► **Shodō** is the discipline of Japanese artistic calligraphy.

LOGISTICS

- Shihan is the highest teaching qualification in traditional disciplines
- Soke indicates the head of a school in a traditional discipline
- Shumeikai Italia is an association that promotes the practice of Aikido according to the technical model of Tamura N. Shihan, Aikikai VIII dan
- ► Mutokukai Europe is an international Aikido network directed by S. Benedetti Shihan, and M.T. Shewan Shihan, both Aikikai VII dan
- ► The European Iaido Federation (FEI) is directed by M.T. Shewan Shihan
- ► The European Jodo Federation (FEJ) is directed by P. Krieger Shihan



TECHNICAL DIRECTION

The three teachers are united by a shared path of research and practice lasting more than twenty years

Trained under

the guidance of some of the most renowned teachers in the world (all *Shihan* and *Soke*), they are officially qualified to teach the disciplines proposed

 In addition to directing courses, they hold teaching responsibilities at a national (CSEN, Shumeikai Italia) and international level (Mutokukai Europe, European Iaido Federation, European Jodo Federation)

► In the SMR four traditional certificates are awarded: the Sho-mokuroku is the second (corresponding to V-VI dan), the Go-mokuroku is the third (VI-VII dan) and the Menkyo-kaiden is the last (VII-VIII dan)

In the FEI and FEJ, official teachers are classified into three levels in ascending order: **Shoden**, **Chūden** and **Kuden**

Tenshinshō-den Katori Shintō-ryū, Mokuroku

► The **Mokuroku** is the first of the three traditional certificates of the Tenshinshō-den Katori Shintō-ryū

► Jun-shidōin is the first of the four teaching qualifications in Ryūshin Shōchi-ryū.
